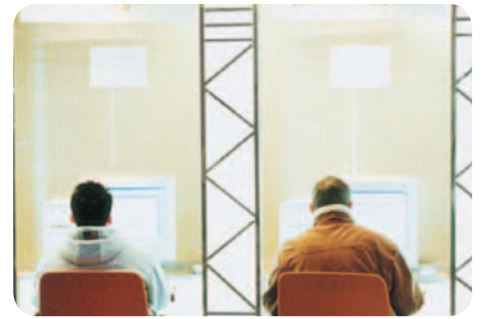

personalised network printing

FollowMe Printing provides easy-to-use security and control, without sacrificing any of the usefulness or cost-effectiveness of network printers or multifunctional products.

In network printing environments, the ease with which you, and only you, get your printouts on shared printers is an important issue. Or maybe you have invested in colour printers, large-format printers or multifunctional products to meet the demands of various users cost-effectively, and you need a way of preventing unauthorised use, and controlling access to extended printer capabilities. Or do you need to route print jobs to different printers to accommodate users who use different desks on each trip to the office?

FollowMe Printing intercepts documents printed from any Windows PC, and holds them until the correct recipient identifies him- or herself at any of the printers designated for their use, before outputting to paper. Individual users can also be assigned credit limits, to prevent the misuse of expensive resources or consumables, and designated time zones to allow printing or copying at certain times only.

how FollowMe Printing works

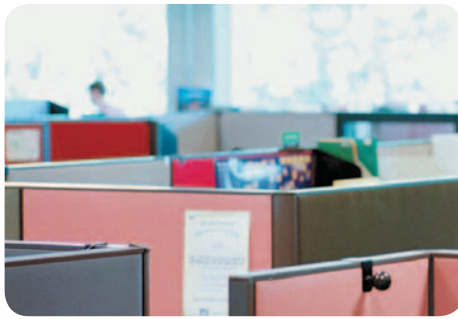
FollowMe Printing starts with the port monitor, on the user's computer, that routes print jobs to the FollowMe Queue Server software, which runs on a Windows PC. The FollowMe Printing identification device is connected to the LAN and located close to any networked HP printer. Depending on the version of FollowMe Printing, the identification device uses PIN codes, fingerprints, magnetic swipe cards, or proximity cards to identify the user and release the print job. Between submitting the print job and releasing it, the user can control it using the FollowMe Client software on their PC, which lets them Print & Retain, Print & Delete, Delete, view or print the job list, manipulate document details, or request additional copies after proof reading.

An optional cable, to connect the FollowMe Printing identification device to the copy unit of the HP LaserJet MFP, extends authorised access and tracking to valuable copy functionalities too.



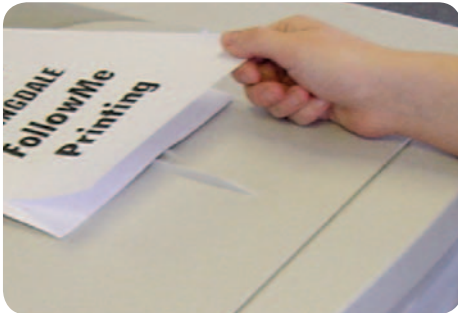
Printed on an HP Colour LaserJet Printer

FollowMe administration, running as part of the FollowMe Queue Server software, makes it possible to assign printer restrictions and permissions to different users, and to extract information on print jobs including the user, printer, number of pages, time and date, to help compile accurate records of printing and copying costs.



characteristics

- controlled printing and copying – restrict use as necessary
- convenient printing – users print when and where they like
- collect from any location (LAN, WAN, intranet)
- monitor printing and copying costs, generate reports on an individual or departmental basis
- additional printing options available (number of copies, job retention or deleting) to control printing and eliminate waste
- a variety of identification methods: proximity card, magnetic swipe card, PIN, or fingerprint (biometric) readers are available



areas of application

- personal printing from shared printers
- ensuring sensitive documents are not left unattended in the printer's output tray
- controlling the use of printing and copying resources and consumables

special features

- direct and simple Ethernet connection to identification device
- prints to all internal or external print servers
- prints to all networked HP printers
